These two Land-marked buildings in Brooklyn were gutted, reconfigured and rehabilitated to provide 21 new units of supportive housing for formerly homeless women and their children, and women recently released from incarceration.

Both four story walk-ups date from the turn of the century; OCV's historic restoration work returned them to their original condition. And yet despite their age, the buildings were designed to meet contemporary sustainability goals, fulfilling the requirements for Enterprise Green Communities certification.
